


BIRDS OF COLOMBIA FROM YOUR LENSES

Day 2. Andes Bird Observatory & Hummingbirds observatory / Night: Hilton Garden Hotel Andes Bird Observatory / Guasca



At 2,700 meters above sea level in the enchanting Guasca, Cundinamarca, the Los Andes Observatory offers an immersion into the high-Andean forest ecosystem. This destination is celebrated for its exclusive Muisca Antpitta and hummingbird observatories, revealing a vibrant mosaic of biodiversity. The reserve is a sanctuary for around thirty captivating bird species, each adding to the rich tapestry of life that graces this place. Whether magical you're dedicated nature enthusiast or an avid birdwatcher, the Los Andes Observatory promises an unforgettable journey into one of the world's most breathtaking natural realms.

Hummingbird Observatory / La Calera

Just 45 minutes from Bogotá, the Hummingbird Observatory is situated on a charming farmhouse adjacent to the buffer zone of Chingaza National Park. Although direct access to the forest is not available, the specially installed feeders attract a dazzling array of hummingbird species. In addition to the hummingbirds, the gardens occasionally host other birds typical of secondary growth in high-Andean forests. This makes the observatory an excellent spot for capturing stunning photographs and easily spotting species that are otherwise elusive in the wild. With its serene setting and abundant birdlife, the Hummingbird Observatory offers a delightful and relaxed environment for both birdwatching enthusiasts and photographers.

Day 3. El Fute and Campo Tangara Reserve, flight to Cali / Night: Sonesta Cali El Fute Reserve Feeders / Cundinamarca

At an elevation of 2,600 meters above sea level, this natural reserve boasts a stunning cloud forest, situated on the edge of the Tequendama fault. Located between the municipalities of Bojaca and San Antonio del Tequendama, the reserve is enveloped by pristine, rugged forests that remain largely untouched due to their steep terrain. This location is seamlessly connected to Chicaque Natural Park, enhancing its rich biodiversity and supporting an impressive array of bird species, as well as diverse flora and fauna. With 33 years of dedicated conservation and restoration efforts, the reserve, in collaboration with the Bogotá Association of Ornithology, has recently opened its doors to birdwatchers. This emerging birdwatching destination offers a unique opportunity to explore its vibrant ecosystems. Access is conveniently located via the Mosquera-La Mesa road, at kilometer 16.

Sonso Lake Natural Reserve / Buga

Day 7. Montezuma all day / Night: Montezuma Reserve Cerro Montezuma Rainforest Natural Reserve / Pueblo Rico

Montezuma Natural Reserve, nestled along the western flank of the Western Cordillera, is a stunning part of the Tatama National Park buffer zone. This pristine reserve features a 14-kilometer road that ascends from the reserve's lodge to the summit of Cerro Tatama, where a military base is situated. The reserve's unique blend of Andean and Chocoan ecosystems creates an exceptionally rich environment for birdwatching and biodiversity. Montezuma is renowned for its impressive bird diversity, with over 520 species recorded, including many restricted and endemic varieties native to this lush, tropical rainforest. Managed by the Tapasco family, led by Leopoldina and her five daughters, the reserve offers an unparalleled birdwatching experience. In addition to its avian wonders, Montezuma is a haven for observing orchids, bromeliads, butterflies, amphibians, and reptiles. This biodiverse paradise provides an extraordinary opportunity to explore the Chocoan biogeographic region, one of the most ecologically rich areas in the world.

Day 9. La Rivera and Tinamú Reserve / Night: QUO La Rivera Reserve / Quindio

Located at kilometer 4 on the Morro Azul road in Filandia, Quindío, La Rivera Reserve protects and conserves 320 hectares of this magical territory, largely covered by native forest, natural springs, and wetlands that feed into the Barbas River. The reserve boasts incredible biodiversity and offers stunning views of Los Nevados National Natural Park. Visitors can enjoy a guided birdwatching walk, with opportunities to spot a wide variety of species along forest edges, at feeders, and deep within the forest. The walk can be tailored to your preference- either short or extended, the reserve is home to several sought-after highlights such as the Andean Motmot, Cauca Guan , Golden-headed Quetzal and many more.

Tinamú Natural Reserve / Manizales







The reserve boasts a 5-kilometer network of trails with moderate difficulty, offering excellent opportunities to photograph bird species that are not drawn to the feeders. Day 10. Rio Blanco Reserve, transfer Termales del Ruiz/ Night: Termales del Ruiz Hotel Rio Blanco Natural Reserve / Manizales



The Rio Blanco Natural Reserve, an Important Bird Area (IBA), is a vital sanctuary located on the cloud forests that surround the city of Manizales. This protected reserve plays a crucial role in conserving the city's water resources while preserving its Andean and high-Andean ecosystems. Home to over 450 bird species, including many endemics with restricted ranges, Rio Blanco is renowned for its remarkable birdwatching opportunities. The reserve's standout attractions include its Antpitta and Hummingbird feeders, making it one of the world's premier locations to observe Antpittas. Additionally, the reserve offers high-quality lodging that is perfectly suited for owl watching. As one of the most popular birdwatching destinations in Colombia, Rio Blanco is also one of the most extensively studied areas by bird enthusiasts!

Day 11. Hacienda El Bosque, Los Nevado National park / Termales del Ruiz Hacienda El Bosque / Manizales

With a current bird list of over 120 species, Hacienda El Bosque is a premier destination for bird enthusiasts and nature lovers alike.


Day 12. Demostrativa Don Miguel, transfer Jardín / Night: Valdivia Hotel Demostrativa Don Miguel


